

AY 2022 application guidelines for the "Keio Engineering Foundation scholarship"

Details

1. Application period: January 6 (Thu.)-January 28 (Fri.), 2022
2. Eligibility to apply: Those who meet the following conditions
 - (1) Those enrolled or planning to enroll in a doctoral degree program at the Graduate School of Science and Technology in the 2022 academic year; however, your period of enrollment must not exceed the standard period of enrollment for the degree program in which you are enrolled, including the year of admission.
 - (2) Must be fully motivated to conduct research and be recognized as capable of producing excellent research achievements.
 - (3) Must be able to participate in ceremonies and events hosted by the Keio Engineering Foundation.
3. Eligibility to receive scholarship and combination with other scholarships:

Combination with AY 2022 internal scholarships is not permitted.

Furthermore, if you are receiving a scholarship elsewhere or if you have been selected as a Research Fellow of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS), Research Associate (Non-tenured)/Research Assistant, or RA for the Program for Leading Graduate Schools, this would be taken into consideration during the screening process.
4. Number of students that will be recommended: 3 students
5. Scholarship amount: 700,000 yen
6. Scholarship duration: 1 year from April 2022
7. Documents to submit:
 - (1) Scholarship Application (prescribed format)
 - (2) Scholarship Personal Statement and Research Plan (prescribed format, one A4 sheet)
 - (3) Academic Accomplishments (prescribed format)
 - (4) Recommendatory Letter (prescribed format)
 - (5) Latest academic transcript (undergraduate and master's program)

※All documents can be downloaded from the Faculty of Science and Technology website. Combine (1) and (2) together into a single Word file, convert (5) into a PDF file and submit via the Google form below; submit (3) and (4) through your supervisor. Your supervisor will be separately informed how to submit (3) and (4) via Google form.

8. Screening method: Document screening only

Note: The Graduate School of Science and Technology will treat your selection as a "recommendation." The Keio Engineering Foundation will conduct a final screening, and if you pass, you will be "selected."

9. Announcement of results: Late March 2022 (planned)
