AY 2022 application guidelines for the "Atsushi Tamura Memorial Scholarship for Graduate

## Study"

This scholarship was established with the funds from part of the assets donated by Mr. Tatsuji Tamura in memory of his late son, Atsushi Tamura. After graduating from the Department of Administration Engineering at the Keio University Faculty of Science and Technology in 1984 and completing the master's degree program in administration engineering at the Graduate School of Science and Technology in 1986, Atsushi Tamura was engaged in research related to information and computers, but died young on September 13, 1993.

Respecting the purpose of the donation from Mr. Tamura, the "Atsushi Tamura Memorial Scholarship for Graduate Study" was established at the Keio University Graduate School of Science and Technology, and scholarships are provided with the aim of encouraging research among graduate students aspiring to become researchers.

We will be accepting applications for the "Atsushi Tamura Memorial Scholarship for Graduate Study" in accordance with the above, and students wishing to apply for this scholarship should follow the guidelines below.

## **Details**

- 1. Application period: January 6 (Thu.)-January 28 (Fri.), 2022
- 2. Eligibility to apply: Those who meet the following conditions
  - (1) Those enrolled or planning to enroll in a doctoral degree program at the Graduate School of Science and Technology in the 2022 academic year.
  - (2) Must be of excellent character and have outstanding academic grades.
  - (3) Must be recognized as having the qualities to become an outstanding researcher in the future.
  - (4) Must understand the purpose of this scholarship.
- 3. Eligibility to receive scholarship and combination with other scholarships:

Combination with AY 2022 internal scholarships or the Keio Engineering Foundation scholarship is not permitted.

Furthermore, if you are receiving a scholarship elsewhere or if you have been selected as a Research Fellow of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS), Research Associate (Non-tenured)/Research Assistant, or RA for the Program for Leading Graduate Schools, this may be taken into consideration during the screening process.

- 4. Number of recipients: 3 students
- 5. Scholarship amount: 650,000 yen

Payments will be made twice per year, with half of the yearly amount being paid each time.

6. Scholarship duration: 1 year from April 2022

## 7. Documents to submit:

- (1) Scholarship Application (prescribed format)
- (2) Scholarship Personal Statement and Research Plan (prescribed format, one A4 sheet)
- (3) Academic Accomplishments (prescribed format)
- (4) Recommendatory Letter (prescribed format)
- (5) Latest academic transcript (undergraduate and master's program)
