We will be accepting applications for the "Fujiwara Scholarship" in accordance with the above, and students wishing to apply for this scholarship should follow the guidelines below.

- 1. Application period: October 1 (Tue.) October 7 (Mon.), 2024
- 2. Eligibility: Applicants must meet the following conditions.
  - (1) Those who entered the Doctoral Program of the Graduate School of Science and Technology in September 2024.
  - (2) Must be of excellent character and have outstanding academic grades.
  - (3) Must be recognized as having the qualities to become an outstanding researcher in the future.
  - (4) The research activities you conduct to obtain your degree must have the potential of being highly regarded internationally.
  - (5) Must understand the purpose of this scholarship.
- 3. Funding eligibility:

Combination with AY 2024 internal scholarships or the Keio Engineering Foundation scholarship is not permitted.

Furthermore, receipt of another scholarship, a salary, or other financial aid will be taken into consideration in the selection process.

4. Number of nominees: Approx. 5 people

- 5. Scholarship amount: 500,000 yen
- 6. Period of disbursement: for half a year (September 2024 March 2025)
