Mr. Yuzo Fujiwara, the head of the Fujiwara family and a Keio alumnus, donated considerable funds to establish a scholarship system for the students at the Graduate School of Science and Technology, on the purpose of which he stated: "in order to develop talented human resources who can contribute to the world through science and technology, a scholarship program for undergraduate and graduate students who actively engage in international activities will be implemented. Furthermore, students who make achievements in extracurricular activities that are highly regarded by society will be commended."

In order to express our gratitude to the Fujiwara family for their significant contributions as well as to commemorate their role, Keio University established the "Keio University Faculty of Science and Technology and Graduate School of Science and Technology Fujiwara Scholarship Fund" at the Graduate School of Science and Technology, and provides scholarships to those who serve as model students. After being selected as a Fujiwara Scholarship student, you will be invited to attend an award ceremony and a commemorative party. Additionally, every year, there is a social gathering which is attended by Mr. Yuzo Fujiwara and past scholarship recipients, providing an opportunity to deepen exchange even after graduation.

We will be accepting applications for the "Fujiwara Scholarship" in accordance with the above, and students wishing to apply for this scholarship should follow the guidelines below.

- 1. Application period: January 6 (Wed.)-January 29 (Fri.), 2021
- 2. Eligibility to apply: Those who meet the following conditions
 - (1) Those enrolled or planning to enroll in a doctoral degree program at the Graduate School of Science and Technology in the 2021 academic year; however, your period of enrollment must not exceed the standard period of enrollment for the degree program in which you are enrolled, including the year of admission.
 - (2) Must be of excellent character and have outstanding academic grades.
 - (3) Must be recognized as having the qualities to become an outstanding researcher in the future.
 - (4) The research activities you conduct to obtain your degree must have the potential of being highly regarded internationally.
 - (5) Must understand the purpose of this scholarship.
- 3. Eligibility to receive scholarship and combination with other scholarships:

Combination with AY 2021 internal scholarships or the Keio Engineering Foundation scholarship is not permitted.

Furthermore, if you are receiving a scholarship elsewhere or if you have been selected as a Research Fellow of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS), Research Associate (Non-tenured)/Research Assistant, or RA for the

Program for Leading Graduate Schools, this may be taken into consideration during the screening process.

4. Number of recipients: Maximum of 11 students

5. Scholarship amount: 1,000,000 yen

Payments will be made twice per year, with half of the yearly

amount being paid each time.
