## Objective

Since 2005, the beginning of the master's double degree program with the Ecole Centrale group in France, the Faculty and the Graduate School of Science and Technology at Keio University have developed a number of double degree programs with higher educational institutions in several other European countries. Today, we have master's double degree programs with a total of seventeen schools from France, Germany, Italy, Belgium, Sweden, Spain, and Poland. As we celebrate the 20th anniversary of our double degree program, we will hold a commemorative symposium to trace the history of the program, as well as discussing the future of double degree programs and joint programs in global society, with the prospect of a brain circulation ecosystem. This symposium aims to serve our three stakeholders: society, educational institutions, and students.

慶應義塾大学理工学部・理工学研究科は 2005 年にフランス Ecole Centrale グループとの修士学位ダブルディグリープログラムを開始して以来、欧州各国の高等教育機関とのダブルディグリープログラムを発展させてきました。現在では、フランス、ドイツ、イタリア、ベルギー、スウェーデン、スペイン、ポーランドの計 17 校と修士学位ダブルディグリープログラムを展開しています。本年 20 年を迎えるにあたり、これまでの沿革を振り返るとともに、これからのダブルディグリープログラムやグローバル社会の中での共同プログラムの在り方、社会、教育機関、学生の三者をステークホルダーとする頭脳循環エコシステムの展望を議論する記念シンポジウムを開催します。

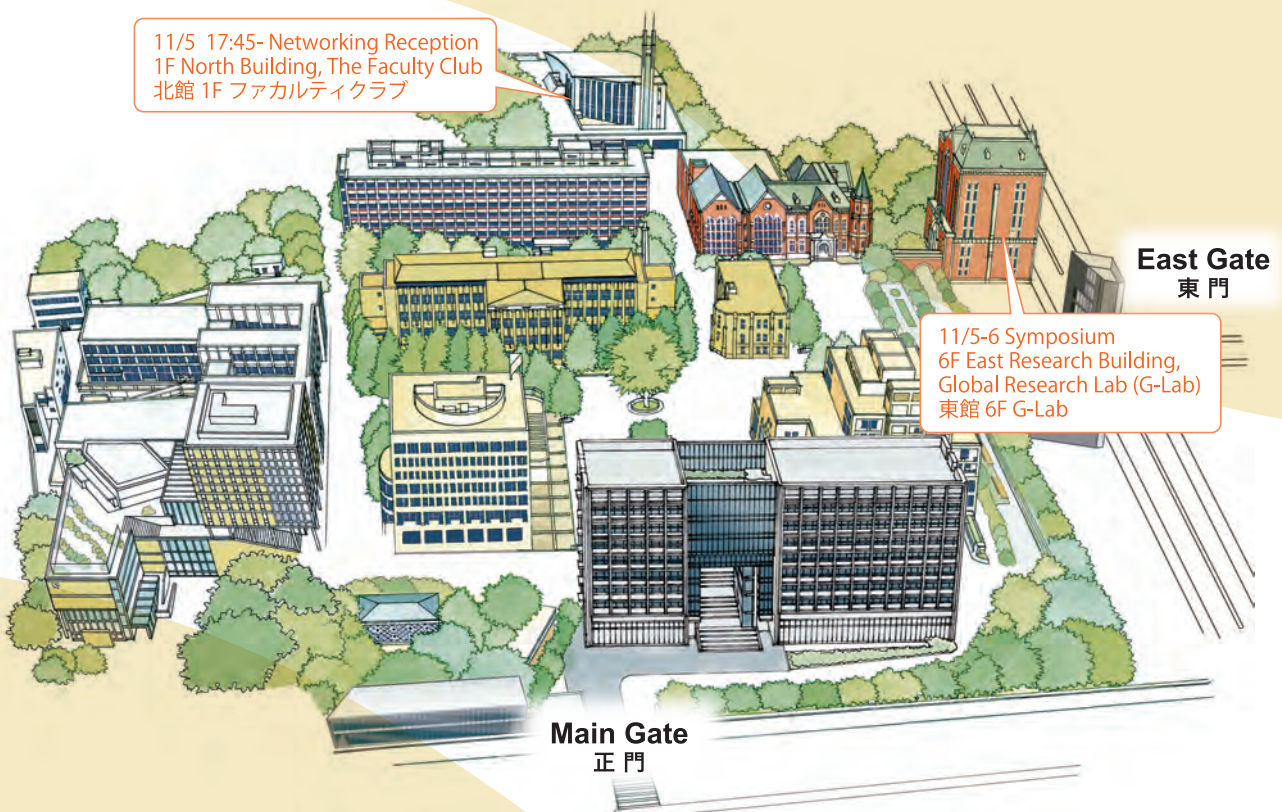
