AY 2025 application guidelines for the "Keio Engineering Foundation scholarship"

Details

1. Application period January 6 (Mon.)-January 27 (Mon.), 2025

2. Eligibility: Applicants must meet the following conditions:

(1) Those enrolled or planning to enroll in a doctoral degree program at the Graduate School of Science and Technology in the 2025 academic year. However, your period of enrollment must not exceed the standard period of enrollment for the degree program in which you are enrolled, including the year of admission.

(2) Must be fully motivated to conduct research and be recognized as capable of producing excellent research achievements.

(3) Must be able to participate in ceremonies and events hosted by the Keio Engineering Foundation.

3. Funding eligibility:

Combination with AY 2025 internal scholarships is not permitted. In addition, if you are employed on a full-time/regular basis or have been selected as a JSPS Research Fellow (DC1/DC2), Research Associate/Assistant (Non-tenured), or for the JST Doctoral Program Student Support Project (Keio-SPRING) as of AY 2025, you are not eligible to receive this scholarship. (I. e., your application for this scholarship will not be considered.) Furthermore, if you receive another scholarship elsewhere in AY 2025, that fact may be taken into consideration in the selection process.

- 4. Number of students that will be recommended: 3 students
- 5. Scholarship amount: 700,000 yen
- 6. Scholarship duration: 1 year starting in April 2025
- 7. Items to submit:
 - (1) Google Form (<u>https://forms.gle/pjdPjERjfe76K5uz7</u>)
 - (2) Transcript of academic record for undergraduate and graduate degrees
 - (3) List of research accomplishments (prescribed form)
 - (4) Recommendation of Academic Advisor for Scholarship Application
 - *All prescribed forms can be downloaded from the website of the Faculty of Science and Technology. Submit (2) as a PDF through the Google Form. Only submit transcripts of academic record for doctoral programs if completed coursework falls outside of "Graduate Research 2". (3) and (4) must be submitted through an academic advisor. Academic advisors will be separately informed how to submit (3) and (4) by the Office of Student Services.
- 8. Screening Method: Document screening only
 - *Note: The Graduate School of Science and Technology will treat your selection as a "recommendation." Final selection will be made by Keio Engineering Foundation (Mid-April 2025). If you pass the final selection, you will be "adopted" for Keio Engineering Foundation scholarship.

9. Announcement of results: Mid-April 2025 (tentative)

- *Note: Students who are recommended will be contacted in late March 2025. At that time, you will be notified of a separate application document preparation process.
